We encourage and support homework by offering a special area that allows for quiet study and adult interaction and support.

This room opens at 3:15pm and closes at 5:00pm, so children may do homework before or after going outside. Homework is a "choice" activity.

ARTS & CRAFTS DISTRICT

Children interested in exploring their creative side can stop in to try their hand at basic activities with arts and crafts materials.

Guided theme projects are available daily and they can range from pumpkin decorating to creating woven placemats.

TECHNOLOGY SQUARE

In our technology lab, a variety of computer games and learning programs are available to play alone or with a friend.

Adult supervision and interaction is always present.

QUIET GAME & LEGO JUNCTION

Games such as *Mancala*, *Checkers* and *Chess*, as well as other popular board games, are available on a "choice" basis throughout the afternoon to those interested in a friendly challenge.
