## JUNIOR CAMP

### Entering Kindergarten & Grade 1



Our Junior Camp program is specifically tailored for younger campers who need the security of an all day counselor and base camp. Children can sign up in two-week increments where their counselors will customize activities and games around a theme to meet their groups' needs and interests.

The daily camp schedule allows for periods of extended animated fun mixed with quieter times to encourage children to choose activities that interest them. Each morning our camp day begins with an all camp meeting where all groups gather to hear the daily schedule, sing a song and participate in an organized event. During the day counselors will plan organized thematic activities, as well as allow campers free choice time in areas such as arts & crafts, drama, manipulatives and quiet games. Alphabet scavenger hunts, pool splashes, bubble games and crazy karaoke are just some of the spontaneous happenings that take place!

## SENIOR CAMP

### Entering Grades 2-5



Our Senior Camp program allows our older campers to sign up weekly for maximum flexibility. Senior Camp is designed to encourage our older campers to move between designated areas and participate in organized activities that interest them. This freedom allows them to 'choose their fun' while spending time bonding with their friends in a safe environment.

Each morning begins with an opening ceremony where every camper gathers to hear the daily schedule, sing a song and participate in a group activity.
